FM and SHORTWAVE TRANSMITTERS**

Some of our programmes are broadcast simultaneously from these FM transmitters: **Tawa 88.2MHz FM Stereo, Marahau 88.2MHz FM Stereo, Stoke 107.6MHz FM Stereo**, and **Taipei 95.5MHz FM Stereo**. Programmes on Tawa, Marahau & Stoke (New Zealand) are marked*, programmes on Taipei (Taiwan) marked ^. We also use shortwave from time to time, broadcasting on **6,070kHz (49.39 meters)** with a power of 10kW from a transmitter at Rohrbach in Germany. These programmes are marked + Many of our programmes are also rebroadcast at different times and days on AM, FM, and online by our network of affiliate stations around the world. As many stations are currently adapting their schedules due to the Covid-19 emergency, normal schedules are liable to change without notice.

THE FUN ONE

Radio Six took July 1970 off as we were in Pitlochry where there was "no suitable equipment". So a 16-page "Radio News" said, but we know better. There was an operational studio in Pitlochry and programmes were made, including the very first edition of "Teatime With Tony", which was taped there for transmission in Ardrossan. New equipment was designed for the Ardrossan studio, and installed on return at the beginning of August, allowing a resumption of daily programmes on August 10th with "Rise 'n' Shine at 8.30am. Thereafter, the rough daily pattern was for local programmes from 11.15am to noon, Radio 2 from Noon to 1.30pm, and again from 3 to 5pm (with Terry Wogan). "The Fun One" and "the Afternoon Show" with a daily feature programme filled the 1.30 to 3pm slot and after one of the daily 5pm features, "Teatime with Tony" made its debut at 5.30pm on August 10th and appeared most days at the same time. Then a gap from 6.30 to 11pm and local programmes - "Night Spin" - for an hour until the midnight news ended the day. Another unusual programme in that first week back was "Symphony no.1 in S Major", described as 'an experiment in stereophony' recorded in our Donavoured, Pitlochry studio. It was, frankly, a bit odd and was consigned to 10.45pm on Friday night. "Saturday Sounds" returned in its 10pm slot and everything was back to normal. -JACK CARR

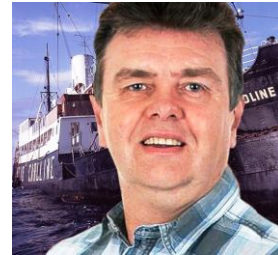
