...NWS BINGHAMTON SYSTEM MAINTENANCE MONDAY THROUGH WEDNESDAY...

This is a reminder that the National Weather Service office in Binghamton, NY will conduct a required, scheduled update to our computer system this coming Monday morning through at least Wednesday afternoon. No impacts to our core services of forecasts, watches, warnings, and advisories are expected. Production of core services will be completed at our back-up office in State College, PA.

However, all NOAA Weather radio transmitters maintained by NWS Binghamton will be off-the-air from the morning of June 2 through at least the afternoon June 4, as well as forecast recordings which are accessed by calling the public phone number 607-729-1597. Also, the usual weekly NOAA Weather Radio test will not occur Wednesday.

Updates of some other items, such as daily climate products, and a few locally-derived items on the NWS Binghamton website, will also be limited as the maintenance is occurring.

The National Weather Service office in Binghamton will remain open and staffed through maintenance period, to continue all communications, operations, and functions which do not depend on the computer system that is being updated.
